About University:

The foundation of Dr Bhimrao Ambedkar University (originally known as Agra University) was laid on the 1st of July, 1927, as a result of hectic efforts of a band of enthusiastic educationists like Rev. Canon A.W. Davis, Munshi Narain Prasad Asthana, Dr L.P. Mathur, Lala Dewan Chand, Rai Bahadur Anand Swaroop and Dr Brajendra Swaroop. Original jurisdiction of University extended over United Provinces of Agra, Central India and Rajputana with 14 affiliated colleges and 2530 students of which, 1475 students belonged to United Provinces. Initially, there were only four faculties in the University viz. Arts, Sciences, Commerce and Law. Faculties of Medicine (1936), Agriculture (1938), Home Science (1980), Basic Sciences (1981), Fine Arts (1982) and Management (1994) were added subsequently. A decisive characteristic in influencing the education of an academic institution is the pursuit of excellence and consistent adherence to high standard in terms of imparting knowledge promoting research. During last eighty three years the University has endeavoured to keep adopting these high ideas and has established rich traditions and evolved respect from the intellectual community. University has sincerely served the cause of higher education in northern India. The ancient principle of integrating ethical and moral values in education has been the endeavour of the University. To inculcate these essential values in its students academicians have been assiduously trying to sharpen the content and curriculum of the University.

The Agra University was renamed as Dr Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra. The University now caters to the educational need of the seven districts of Agra Division Agra, Aligarh, Mainpuri, Hathras, Firozabad, Etah and Mathura. Besides, the University is proud of having affiliated to it, Sarojini Naidu Medical College, which is one of the oldest and premier Medical Institute of the country. At present university has approx 200 affiliated colleges and 15 residential Institutes spread out in its four residential campus viz. Paliwal Park, Khandari Campus, Civil Lines Campus and Chhaleshar Campus. Furthermore, this university affiliates colleges of Homeopathy, extending all over the State of U.P.

Courses Offered

- **Bachelor of pharmacy(B.Pharm)**

Eligibility criteria:

A candidate seeking admission to First Semester of above mentioned courses must have passed: Senior School Certificate Examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi (12 year Course) or the Indian School Examination with English as one of the subject and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M) and/or Biology (P.C.B. / P.C.M.B.) as optional subjects with 55% or above marks* in aggregate (theory and practical) and individually in three science subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics) from Recognized Schools.

or

10+2 examination conducted by the respective state / central government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M.) and/or Biology (P.C.B. / P.C.M.B.) as optional subjects with 55 % or above marks* in aggregate (theory and practical) and individually in three science subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics)

or

Any other equivalent qualification including National Institute of Open Schooling approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

Candidates who have been awarded grades in the examination which make them eligible for admission should also submit conversion certificate of numerical marks from the concerned authority.

Provided that a student should have completed 17 years of age on the date of admission or should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December 2022.

- **B.Pharm. Lateral Entry**

Eligibility Criteria:

A candidate seeking admission to B. Pharm. Lateral Entry (to Second Year/Third semester) must have passed D. Pharm. courses as per the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act as per regulation 4. B. of the Bachelor of Pharmacy course Regulations, 2014.

- **Diploma in Pharmacy**

Diploma in Pharmacy covers fundamental **Pharmacy Education** including the application of chemistry in the pharma industry, theoretical & practical concepts of biochemistry, pharmacology and toxicology. The course enables the students to study about different chemical salts, their application and uses in medicine. The programme holds fine significance in the pharmaceutical industry.

Eligibility Criteria :

Minimum eligibility qualification is 10+2 level of education in science stream, from a recognized educational board, for admission into the Diploma in Pharmacy [D. Pharm.] course a minimum aggregate score of 35% (Passing marks) at the 10+2 level is also necessary.

• **Master of Pharmacy (M. Pharm.)**

M.Pharm, or Master of Pharmacy, is a two-year postgraduate pharmacy programme. A graduate student in the B.Pharm programme is educated in the sciences of various fields of pharmacy such as industry, marketing, practise, community, drug discovery, and so on. A graduate, on the other hand, lacks in-depth knowledge and hands-on experience in psychomotor skills in the specialised areas of the pharmacy profession.

The department offers Post graduate programme in three streams of pharmacy

- Pharmaceutics,
- Pharmacognosy
- Pharmaceutical chemistry

Eligibility Criteria :

A candidate seeking admission to First Semester must have passed :

a) B. Pharm. Degree examination of an Indian University established by law in India from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India and has scored not less than 55 % of the maximum marks*(Aggregate of II, III and IV yrs / or III to VIII semesters of B. Pharm.)

b) Every student, selected for admission to post graduate pharmacy program in University (any PCI approved institution) should have obtained registration with the State Pharmacy Council or should apply for the registration of the same within one month from the date of his/her admission, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled.

A migration certificate issued by the relevant university where the candidate received his or her qualifying degree must be submitted as a requirement. At the time of application submission, a mark sheet must also be sent (a tentative mark sheet from the university is acceptable).

• **Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D)**

The first two years of the PharmD programme are devoted to fundamental pharmacy studies, and the final four years are spent in a clinical setting.

From the fourth year PharmD students are fully assimilated into the 1200-bed SN Medical College and Hospital's multidisciplinary, multi-specialty health care team. Their final year culminates in a superior, all-inclusive multi-specialty internship. Interns may also receive training at other reputable institutions in India.

Eligibility Criteria:

(1) 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the following subjects: Mathematics or Biology.

(2) A pass in D.Pharm course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

(3) Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations. Provided that a student should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the course.

Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate)

D (Post Baccalaureate) The Pharm D (PB) course offered by the Department is a professional doctorate degree in pharmacy which focuses on core pharmacy courses in the period of three years duration, divided into two phases – Phase I – consisting of First and Second academic year.

Eligibility Criteria

A pass in B.Pharm from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act
