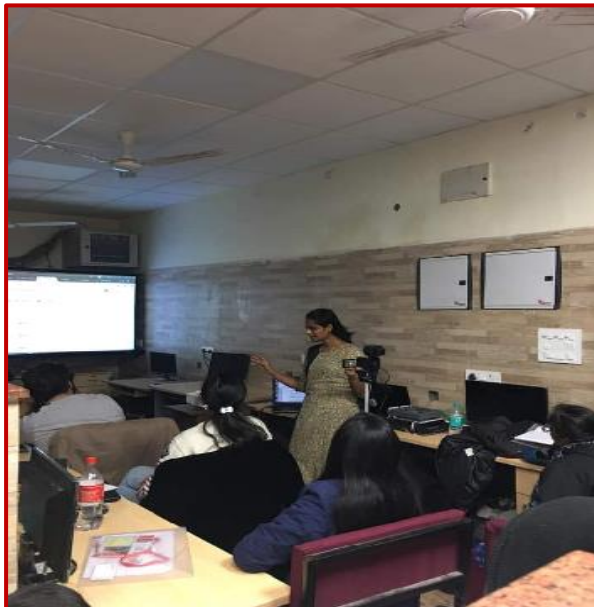

**LEARNING THROUGH MOTHER LANGUAGE**



**INDIAN SCENARIO**

Native language education is more inclusive — but with 200+ spoken languages in India, it could leave India's tech ecosystems splintered.

Of the 10 million students who take high school finals in India every year, 65% come from non-English medium schools. However, higher education in the country, especially in STEM subjects, is currently almost entirely English based.

**SOLUTIONS**

Certain measures have been taken by the Government to implement learning in Mother Language, even indicated in NEP 2020. The growing demand for accessing digital services in local languages forced the state to allocate money for the creation of a National Language Translation Mission last year, with the sole focus of expanding local-language translation.

India's apex body for technical education, All India Council for Technical Education, has bolstered efforts to translate online courses to eight Indian languages.
