MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN DR. BHIMRAO AMBEDKAR UNIVERSITY, AGRA AND VRINDAVAN RESEARCH INSTITUTE, VRINDAVAN

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this ____ day of ____, 20, by and between Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra, hereinafter referred to as "DBRAU, Agra," and Vrindavan Research Institute, Vrindavan, hereinafter referred to as "VRI," collectively referred to as "Parties."

1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this MoU is to establish a framework for mutual collaboration between DR.

BHIMRAO AMBEDKAR UNIVERSITY, AGRA and Vrindavan Research Institute,


Vrindavan, in various academic and research areas. Both institutions seek to foster a long-term

partnership that promotes knowledge sharing, faculty and student exchange, and joint research
initiatives.

2. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

The collaboration between the two institutions will include, but is not limited to, the following activities:

- Workshops and Seminars: Joint organization of national and international workshops, conferences, and seminars on topics of mutual interest.
- Faculty and Student Exchange: Facilitation of faculty and student exchange programs to enhance academic learning, research exposure, and cross-cultural understanding.
- Joint Research and Publications: Encouragement of joint research projects, co-authored publications, and interdisciplinary studies.
- Skill Development Initiatives: Training and development programs for faculty members and students.



- Resource Sharing: Access to academic and research resources, such as libraries, laboratories, and digital archives.
- Internship and Industry Collaboration: Facilitation of internships and industry collaborations to provide practical exposure to students.
- 7. Curriculum Development: Cooperation in designing and improving curriculum to align with industry and academic advancements.
- Funding and Grant Applications: Joint efforts to secure research funding from national and international funding agencies.
- Cultural and Educational Exchange Programs: Collaboration in cultural exchange activities, academic visits, and educational tours.

3. IMPLEMENTATION MECHANISM

- A joint committee comprising representatives from both institutions shall oversee the implementation of activities under this MoU.
- Both parties shall designate a coordinator responsible for planning and executing collaborative initiatives.
- Periodic meetings shall be conducted to evaluate the effectiveness of the partnership and explore further opportunities.

4. DURATION AND RENEWAL

This MoU shall be valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing and may be extended upon mutual consent.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

Any intellectual property generated from joint research or activities shall be subject to a mutually agreed-upon policy, ensuring fair recognition and rights to all contributors.

6. TERMINATION

R. NO. 7753/09 District - AGRA

Either party may terminate this MoU by providing a three (3) months' written notice to the other party. Any ongoing activities shall be completed or transitioned smoothly.

7. GENERAL TERMS

- This MoU is a non-binding agreement and does not create any legal or financial obligations.
- Any disputes arising from this MoU shall be resolved amicably through discussions.
- Amendments to this MoU shall be made in writing with the mutual agreement of both institutions.
