General Instructions:

- The University reserves the right to:
 - Withdraw any advertised post(s) at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
 - Not to fill up any of the advertised positions.
 - Increase or decrease the number of posts.
- The Qualifications, Pay Scales and other Conditions for the advertised positions shall be in accordance with the UGC Regulations-2018/AICTE-2019/PCI notification No. 14-163/2021-PCI/12730, date: 08.08.2022 and U.P. State Government's rules in this regard.
- Candidates are advised to satisfy themselves before applying, that they possess Essential Qualifications as laid down in the Advertisement.
- The selection procedure for teaching positions shall be as laid down by the Chancellor Secretariat's Office Orders 2021 and UGC Regulations 2018 on 'Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff
- Candidates are requested to carefully read the General Information & Instructions before filling up the Online Application Form available on the University Website: www.dbrau.ac.in.
- The Candidates are also advised to visit the university website as well as their online application uploaded on the Samarth Website, periodically for further information and updates related to the recruitment process.
- Candidates who have been awarded Ph.D. from foreign Universities should enclose "Equivalence Certificate issued by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, without which their candidature will not be considered and application will be rejected. However, the persons who have acquired Ph.D. degree from Foreign University through nomination by MHRD's Foreign Scholarship Programme will be exempted from the Equivalency Certificate.
- The online application process shall start on **02.03.2026** and the last date for filling online application **17.04.2026**.

9. The application process is online only. However, print out of online application along with photocopy of relevant certificate(s) and document(s) in support of educational qualification and service experience should be submitted to the office of the Registrar, Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra in a sealed. envelope by registered/speed post. The Sealed Envelope should be super scribed with a heading: "Application for the post of < Name & Discipline of the post>". The hardcopy of the application send by registered/ speed post must reach to the office of the Registrar within 10 days from the last date for online submission of the application i.e.

10. Application, incomplete in any respect and without relevant Certificates/Documents/Photographs/Orders, desired or without Requisite Fee will be rejected.
11. The application fee is Rs. 3000/- (Rs. 2500/- for SC/ST candidates only) which will be paid online along with online application.
12. Application fee once submitted is non-refundable.
13. Candidate applying for more than one position shall apply separately and must submit application fee for each application.
14. The reservation for the posts will be as per the U.P. Govt. norms.
15. Reservation for Persons with Disabilities shall be applicable as per the provisions contained in Government order of Uttar Pradesh, Personnel Section-2 letter No. 10/2022/18/1/2008/47/Ka-2/2022 dated 04.08.2022
16. SC/ST/OBC/EWS/UR stands for Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe, Other Backward Classes, Economically Weaker Section and Unreserved category respectively.
17. SC/ST candidates must enclose with the Application a 'hard copy of the Caste Certificate on prescribed Format of the Government of U P., duly issued by the Competent Authority.
18. OBC (Non-creamy Layer) candidates must enclose with the Application a hard copy of the Caste Certificate/Income Certificate on prescribed Format of the Government of U.P., duly issued by the Competent Authority on or after 01 October, 2025.
19. EWS candidates are required to submit a certificate in prescribed format of the Government of U.P. duly issued by the Competent Authority on or after 01 October, 2025.
20. A candidate already in employment is required to submit the No Objection Certificate' preferably at the time of submitting online application form. However in any situation he/she will not be permitted to appear in the interview without submitting the no objection certificate from his present employer.
21. Experience and Qualifications will be reckoned as on the last date of submission of application form.
22. The service conditions and age of superannuation shall be as per U.P. State Govt, norms.
23. No 'Interim Correspondence' shall be entertained.

Other Instruction:

- A. How to Apply: The duly completed application in the prescribed format should be submitted online through the Samarth portal.
- B. Application Fees: Candidates have to pay application fee Rs. 3000/- (Rs. 2500/- for SC/ST candidates only) fee through 'Online Transaction' along with online application.
- C. Documents required to be submitted with Online Application:**
- Candidates should submit (pdf of scanned copies) of all the supporting documents for all the claims made in the Online Application, viz Eligibility, Achievements; Publications (only first page) etc. along with the proof of the Impact Factor of the Peer Reviewed Journals, Refereed Journals/UGC Approved Journals of each research paper, which has been included in the Academic Score claimed (each page duly signed)
 - Candidates are suggested to upload a merged single PDF file for Mark sheets and Certificate/Degree for respective educational qualifications, wherever required.
 - Candidates are suggested to compile first page (only) of all the research papers, conference proceedings, seminar/symposia/conference abstract, books and book chapters, policy documents, etc. as PDF file and upload on the portal.
 - Candidates are suggested to merge the supporting documents for multiple research projects, patents, consultancy, awards, etc., respectively, as PDF files and upload on the portal.
 - Other documents can be uploaded in "Other" section"
 - The University will get verified all the documents in support of qualifications, experience etc. submitted by candidate, from the issuing authority. If any document is found to be false/fake/incorrect at any stage of verification before or after appointment, the document in question shall lead to termination of his/her appointment.
 - While filling online application form candidates are suggested to fill absolute numerical values rather than in decimal or in fractions.
 - The application process is online only but candidates are required to submit the hardcopy of the duly filled Application Form along with supporting documents (each page duly signed) by Registered/Speed post to The Registrar, Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra -282004 (UP) The hardcopy of the application send by registered/ speed post must reach to the office of the Registrar within 10 days from the last date for online submission of the application i.e. 27.04.2026. The envelope on its top shall mention the advertisement number, post applied, and department name.

Note: The data once entered shall not be allowed to change, therefore, the candidate should check the entries before final submission.

A. Screening and Selection Criteria for various Teaching Positions

(in accordance with Governor Secretariate, U.P. Order Nos. 4229/JS dt.02-07-2021; 5862/JS dt. 03-09-2021; 2385/JS dt. 28-04-2022; 3019/32-JS/2020 dt. 18-05-2023 and UGC-Regulations 2018)

The details of weightage/points to be assigned for various components/criteria for recruitment to various teaching positions is given in Table 1 below:

Note:

- i. A "Scrutiny Committee" shall be constituted for checking and scrutinizing the application forms.
- ii. For the post of Assistant Professor, the selection process shall be conducted in two phases: (i) shortlisting and (ii) interview
- iii. For the post of Assistant Professor, the 'Basic Academic Score and API Score' shall be calculated as per the as per UGC-Regulations 2018, Appendix II, Table 3A.
- iv. For the post of Assistant Professor, there shall be a written objective examination of the relevant discipline/branch of 40 points.
- v. For the post of Assistant Professor, syllabi for written examination, in sciences/humanities & social sciences will be syllabi of NET, in engineering/ technology will be syllabi of GATE & in Pharmacy
- vi. For the post of Assistant Professor, the candidates shall be given a time of at least seven days from the date of publication of cumulative score for Basic Academic Score and API/Research Score, for inviting objections.
- vii. For the post of Assistant Professor, the candidates shall be given a time of at least three days from the date of publication of written examination score, for inviting objections.
- viii. For the post of Assistant Professor, a 'Consolidated Merit List' shall be prepared based on the combined score of 'Basic Academic Score and API Score' and 'written test'. From this merit list appropriate number of candidates shall be shortlisted for 'Interview' which will be conducted in two parts for all discipline (i) Assessment of teaching skills and (ii) Interview.
- ix. For the post of Assistant Professor final selection will be based on performance in assessment of teaching skill and interview taken together (but not less than 50% of total score i.e.15 marks) for shortlisted candidates selected for Phase 2 of the selection process after written examination.
- x. A duly constituted "Selection Committee" will conduct the interview process and shall submit the final result in sealed envelope to the Vice Chancellor.

Other Instruction:

In the 'Direct Recruitment' for teaching positions, there shall be a 'Waiting List' of not more than two candidates and it shall remain valid for one year from declaration of result.

Calculation of the API/Research score for the post of Assistant Professor will be as per the details given in Table 3 (as per UGC-Regulations 2018, Appendix II, Table 3A).

- (B) Score shall be valid for appointment in Uttar Pradesh SLET/ SET University/Colleges/ SET University/Colleges/Institutions only.

**Note: University may grade Ph.D. awarded candidates for the ranking of their degree awarding university/institute. Candidate awarded with Ph.D. from NAAC "A" graded / NIRF top hundred ranked universities/institutions, in accordance with UGC-regulations, will be given 30 marks while others*

may be granted marks in a justified proportion. Point scored by the candidate will be weighed down to 30%.

The Research score for research papers would be augmented as follows:

Peer-Reviewed or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list):

- a. Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

Note:

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
- The API/Research score secured -by candidates as per Table 4 shall be scaled down to a maximum of 50.

Other Guidelines:

For the purpose of minimum essential qualification for the posts in subjects not covered/governed under UGC-Regulations, the regulations of their respective governing bodies/statutory bodies shall be exercised.
